Stage Manager (SM)

The Stage manager is responsible for the smooth running of their stage during the show, and keeping everything running to schedule. You will be working on one of the festival's smaller stages or tents.

Your duties as SM will include:

- Ensuring all technical equipment is fully operational, and contacting the appropriate member of staff should equipment fail
- Greeting and preparing artists with their technical needs, with the AL (artist liaison)
- Communicate in a clear, concise and timely manner with artists, stage technicians, AL and runners
- Trouble shoot and communicate to provide information to resolve issues.
- Maintain cleanliness and order in all areas stage side, including backstage areas.

Your Profile

You will possess the ability to work within a team, ideally with a knowledge of stage management and basic lighting and sound, although this is non-essential and training can be provided if needs be.

You will enjoy working in a busy exciting live music environment, and want to improve your SM skills by working on a large scale event. You will want a more responsible role and you are confident of your ability to handle challenging issues.

Knowledge of event health and safety issues and challenges around event management a bonus but not essential as we will provide H&S training.

- Health and safety and crowd management professionals.
