

Crystal Palace Bake Off 2019 – Terms and Conditions

The Crystal Palace Bake Off is in aid of the Crystal Palace Festival and is organized by the Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC.

Best Presentation and Best Tasting Cake Competition

- These terms and conditions are known as the 'Rules'. Words used in the description of the Competition (the Competition Description) shall have the same meaning when used here. In the event of any conflict between the Competition Description and the Rules, the Rules shall prevail.
- The Rules apply to “The Crystal Palace Bake Off” and by entering the Competition; you agree to be bound by the Rules.
- The competition is to bake a cake. Cakes will be judged on Best Presentation and Best Taste.
- Winners will receive prizes as outlined on the website crystalpalacefestival.org.

Competition Entrants

- By entering the Competition, you hereby warrant that all information submitted by you in your Entry is true, accurate and complete in every respect and that the cake you are submitted for entry was made in its entirety by you. The Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC reserves the right to verify any information contained in your Entry and/or your eligibility to enter the Competition.
- The Competition is only open to persons who are resident in the United Kingdom.
- The Competition is open to all ages.
- Family members of the Judges are not eligible to enter.
- You acknowledge and agree that any failure to comply with the Rules could lead to disqualification.
- In the event that a Prize-winner is disqualified from the Competition for any reason, the Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC will select an alternative Prize-winner in the same manner as the original Prize-winner and such selection will be subject to the Rules.
- Entry only open to amateur bakers.

How to enter the Competition

- Entries must be made by midnight on 14 March 2019 at the link provided on the Festival website page.
- Cakes should be brought to Reunion at 38 Westow Street, London, SE19 3AH between 9am - 10am on 16 March 2019.
- A fee of £5 is payable for all entries.
- Your cake must be at least a 8 inch round cake in diameter or the equivalent as a square shape and yield 12 servings.
- All cake entries must be accompanied by a list of ingredients.
- No purchase is necessary in order to enter the competition.
- You understand that cakes entered for the Competition will not be returned to you after the Competition and will be sold to fundraise for the Crystal Palace Festival.
- Entrants may enter only one cake in the competition.

Competition Judging

- Since entries will be judged on artistic, creative or other subjective criteria, the Crystal Palace Festival reserves the right to set or amend the criteria used to judge entries.
- Judges will include Derek Taylor of Dalhousie, Ashley from Blackbird Bakery and Joe Brett of

Brett & Bailey

- The prize-winners will be chosen by the Judges and the Prize will be awarded to the person who the Judges considers has submitted the best entry using the judging criteria set out in the Competition Description. The Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC will notify the Prize winners on 16 March 2019.
- No Prize will be awarded where any entrant has committed any form of misconduct (as determined by the Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC in its sole discretion).
- In the event of any dispute regarding the Rules, the conduct or results of the Competition, or any other matter relating to a Competition, the decision of the Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC shall be final and unchallengeable and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into, comment issued, or reason given in respect of any decision made by the Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC and/or the Judges of the Competition.
- Prizes are non-transferable and there is no cash alternative. In the event of a Prize being unavailable for any reason the Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC reserve the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value at any time.

Liability

- The Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC will not be liable for any circumstances beyond its reasonable control that prevent the Competition being fulfilled, a winner chosen, or the Prize being taken up or fully enjoyed by the winner of the Competition. The Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC exclude liability to the full extent permitted by law for any cost, claims or losses howsoever caused that arise by reason of any person's entry in to the Competition or the award on non-award to them of the Prize.
- The Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC accepts no responsibility for loss or damage entries to the Competition or for plates, containers etc left with them at the time of Entry.
- You will make the Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC aware of the ingredients and any potential allergens included in your cake.

Intellectual Property Rights and Data Protection

- You agree that the Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC can sell your cakes to raise funds on 16 and 17 March 2019.
- The Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC may use images of your cake and yourself that you provide on social media and for marketing purposes
- The Crystal Palace Festival Group CIC will use the name that you provide with your Entry for the purposes of the Competition and, where you have given your consent, for marketing purposes including the distribution of regular email updates or newsletters. Any personal information relating to you will be used solely by us in accordance with applicable data protection legislation. If you are the chosen prize-winner you unconditionally agree (as a condition of accepting the Prize) to the use of your name and your photograph.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction

The Rules and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with them or their subject matter (including the Competition), existence, negotiation, validity, termination or enforceability (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.

The Courts of England shall have exclusive jurisdiction in relation to any dispute or claim arising out

of or in connection with the Rules or their subject matter, existence, negotiation, validity, termination or enforceability (including non-contractual disputes or claims).
